Principal's Report

- Staffing new teacher to Grade 1/2, Betty Q until the end of October when Karlee VN joins the school; increasing roster of lunch monitors; after-hours custodians
- Student population 119; awaiting approval of a family
- Bussing routes running fairly smoothly; essential that all families use the BusPlanner app for timely communication
- School Improvement Plan focuses on academic excellence and faith formation, aligns with the Board's Strategic Plan (2024-2027) and multi-year spiritual theme: On Fire with the Spirit: Awaken - Illuminate - Rejoice
 - Faith expanding learning opportunities to ensure Catholic Social Teachings. 0 Ontario Catholic Graduate Expectations are widely understood and integrated all programs; Adherence to Religion and Family Life programs; FIAT as leadership group to put into action plans building on CSTs and OCGEs; faith formation; continued partnership with Family of Parishes
 - Math and Literacy Our students will be in the top 15% in the province on EQAO 0 assessments; fidelity to following Math and Literacy Action Plans and use of board-approved resources to support student learning and achievement; curriculum leaders in school to support professional development and support student learning
